\* Infants under 9 months at the start of RSV season (generally November – April)

\*\* Infants 6 months up to and including 8 years of age who have **never** received influenza vaccine in a previous season receive a 2-dose series

\*\*\* Infants 6 months and older should receive 1 dose per year. Medically at-risk children may be eligible for an additional dose

~ Medically at-risk children may be eligible for additional immunizations

+ 2nd dose of immunization can be given as a combined product (MMRV)
